June 27 commercialization showcase to be held at new ETC TechFire® incubator in White Oak

Rockville, Md. — The Montgomery County Economic Development Corporation (MCEDC) will co-host an event for business owners, prospective entrepreneurs and federal researchers to explore technologies available for license and other R&D partnership and commercialization opportunities with scientists and engineers from the Army Research Laboratory (ARL). The June 27 technology showcase will be held at the Energetics Technology Center's (ETC) new TechFire® incubator in White Oak, Md.
